Things to Understand about Dual Enrollment

- 1—Tuition paid by school (up to 1/12th of state aide allowance); **books, transportation, miscellaneous fees paid by student and/or parent**. District form is required. Student must be junior status and have a qualifying test score on PLAN, ACT, PSAT and/or MME by subject area. Courses that students are eligible to take include core classes we don't offer like Chinese, Russian, Astronomy, Philosophy, etc.
- 2—Student may or may not count class for high school credit. In most cases unless a student needs the high school credit to fulfill graduation, guidance counselors advise **not** to count the college class for high school credit because some colleges will not count class if taken for high school credit towards a degree program. If a student does choose to take a college class for high school credit, the class must be pre-approved through the **transfer of credit** form. A 3-5 credit college class may count as 5 credits at Hamtramck High School if **pre-approved**.
- 3—Colleges usually require <u>assessment testing</u> to make sure students are placed correctly. Students must make arrangements to complete assessment testing at the college if required.
- 4—Students must follow all college and/or university <u>rules</u> regarding admission, assessment, placement, registration, online classes (Blackboard and other technology requirements), etc. including guest application and/or dual enrollment process.
